Arrival Time: Saturday, July 23 at 1:30 pm. Contestants will meet at the fair office for a short meeting. Contestants will be given special admission pass and free parking. All owners who accompany the contestants will have free admission.

Rules

1. Entrants must bring their own pooper-scooper and water dish.
2. Contestants are not allowed to wear any clothing or accessories to promote any organization or business.
3. Any inhumane or other inappropriate action to animals by the contestant may cause disqualification, forfeiture of awards, and removal of the contestant and their human from the fairgrounds.
4. Animal health decisions will be made in the best interest of the animal and for the other animals at the fair.
5. No animal shall be admitted or remain on the grounds that shows any evidence of any active, communicable disease.
6. No animal shall be admitted to the fairgrounds from any premises under quarantine for disease.
7. Management reserves the right to require health inspections and/or diagnostic tests to be made before, during, or after animals are on the fairgrounds and to implement disease control procedures which may become necessary in emergencies. Determination by the official judge shall be final and cannot be protested.
8. All contestants must comply with all state and federal animal health regulations and the fair's health requirements.
9. Dogs must be under the control of the handler at all times. Aggressive or uncontrollable dogs may be removed from the competition and asked to leave the fairgrounds.
10. Last year's winner is not eligible to compete.

Release and Waiver

In consideration of my dog's acceptance by the Linn County Fair as an entrant in the Ugliest Dog of Linn County Pageant, it is agreed and understood that neither the State of Oregon, Linn County, its officers, agents, and employees shall be held legally liable or responsible for any loss, injury, or damage which may occur or arise either to myself, my minor child(s), or my dog by reason of the negligence, misconduct, or conduct of any person or entity whatsoever, or whatsoever.
